

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the Commission's letter no. 491/ECI/LET/FUN/SVEEP-II/EGS/2018 dated 10.08.2018 wherein as part of the Direct Outreach program for Training & Capacity building, the CEOs were requested to hold/conduct workshops at IITs, NITs, IIMs and other reputed universities and colleges, at Hon'ble High Courts, with Industry bodies etc. to generate confidence and create awareness amongst the key opinion makers about the EVM/VVPAT system, as these professionals will be able to influence the masses positively.

However, till date report on the aforesaid workshop has not been received from the CEOs except Delhi.

The Commission has reviewed the matter and emphasised the need to galvanise the programme of EVM-VVPAT Awareness and ensure its mission mode completion. Towards this end, the Commission has directed that the Chief Electoral Officers of all States and Union Territories shall immediately carry out EVM/VVPAT Awareness Workshops at State Level for eminent Constitutional Bodies, Prominent Institutions/Organisations and major opinion makers like Hon'ble High Court, notable Industry Associations, major Academic Institutions, Centres of Excellence, National and State level Training Academies, media houses etc.

You are, accordingly, requested to firm up the detailed schedule for the aforesaid Workshop in consultation with the said participating Institutions / Organisations and ensure that the Workshops are conducted before 10th March, 2019 positively. EVM Division will coordinate & arrange for either TEC members or DEC/Directors/Consultants to join at these workshops.
